



## The 40<sup>th</sup> Chinese Control Conference (CCC2021)

### Final Announcement

The 40<sup>th</sup> Chinese Control Conference (CCC2021) will be held on July 26-28, 2021 in Shanghai, China. The Chinese Control Conference, initiated by the Technical Committee on Control Theory (TCCT) of Chinese Association of Automation (CAA), is an international academic conference on control theory and its applications, with an aim to provide a forum for the international community of systems and control to discuss the latest findings and advances in control theories and technologies. The CCC2021 features plenary lectures, contributed and invited sessions, panel discussions, development forums, preconference workshops, oral presentation sessions and poster sessions etc. for academic exchanges. Chinese and English work as the official languages of the conference. The conference proceedings have been included in IEEE Xplore and indexed by EI Compendex since 2006.

#### 2. Registration

##### (1) Online Registration

- Participant with papers:

Please visit the registration page <https://www.cacpaper.com/register/42/user/newRegist>, and provide the information of your registration including your PIN in the TCCT Conference Paper Management System which is used to get your accepted paper list by clicking the “Add Papers” button, select the Paper IDs you want to register and choose the correct page number for each paper (only the paper numbers 7 and 8 make sense actually), then pay the registration fee with your preferred payment method. Please note that if you choose the





payment method with bank transfer, a transfer voucher is suggested to be uploaded to the registration system. After you succeed to submit the registration information and complete the payment, you will get a "Paper Code" for each paper which will be used to submit your final paper in the paper submission system.

### 4. Instruction for Oral and Poster Presentations

(1) **Oral Presentation**

- Oral Presentation Time: 20 minutes (including discussion);







- Each speaker is required to meet his/her session chairs in the corresponding session rooms 10 minutes before the session starts and copy the slides to the computer;
- Each session room is equipped with a projector and a PC (with Microsoft Windows, Microsoft PowerPoint, and Adobe PDF Reader).
- Please make sure that your files are compatible and readable with our operation system by using commonly used fonts and symbols.

### (2) Poster Presentation

The conference will provide an exhibition board (width 0.9m, height 1.2 m) for each poster paper. The boards will be arranged in the order of the papers in the final program. Tape and other materials will be provided on site, and volunteer-assistants will provide necessary help. Posters are required to be condensed and attractive. The characters should be large enough so that they are visible from 1 meter apart.

SCIS-CCC Poster Paper Award is continued in the CCC2021. Detailed principles for the award can be found at the conference website (<http://tcct.amss.ac.cn/>).

During your poster session, the author should stay by your poster paper to explain and discuss your paper with visiting colleagues. The members of the Evaluation Committee of CCC Poster Paper Award will also be there to inspect poster papers. The authors, who do not poster their papers at their poster sessions and/or do not stay by their poster paper, will be considered as No Show.
